


Description of Technologists' Day initiative

Event Planning

A committee comprising of representatives from different sections, regardless of seniority, is set up to brainstorm and exchange



Department Decorations

Provides opportunities for intersection interactions as the department get together to craft and put-up decorations

DURING EVENT

Event with department-wide activities

Physical Activities

Incorporates elements of fun to encourage deeper inter-sections bonding as staff mingle and relax



Casual Setting

Meal gatherings in an **informal** setting allows staff to wind down and have longer conversations



Safe environment created that is distinct from routine clinical work allows people to speak up freely. This provides opportunities to develop hidden potentials, thereby building confidence and engagement


