Introduction

National Neuroscience Institute (NNI) Neuroradiology department provides 24 hours stroke imaging services to patients. Therefore, managing roster and manpower deployment can be quite daunting especially ad hoc request for mutual exchange of duties after the roster has been finalized.

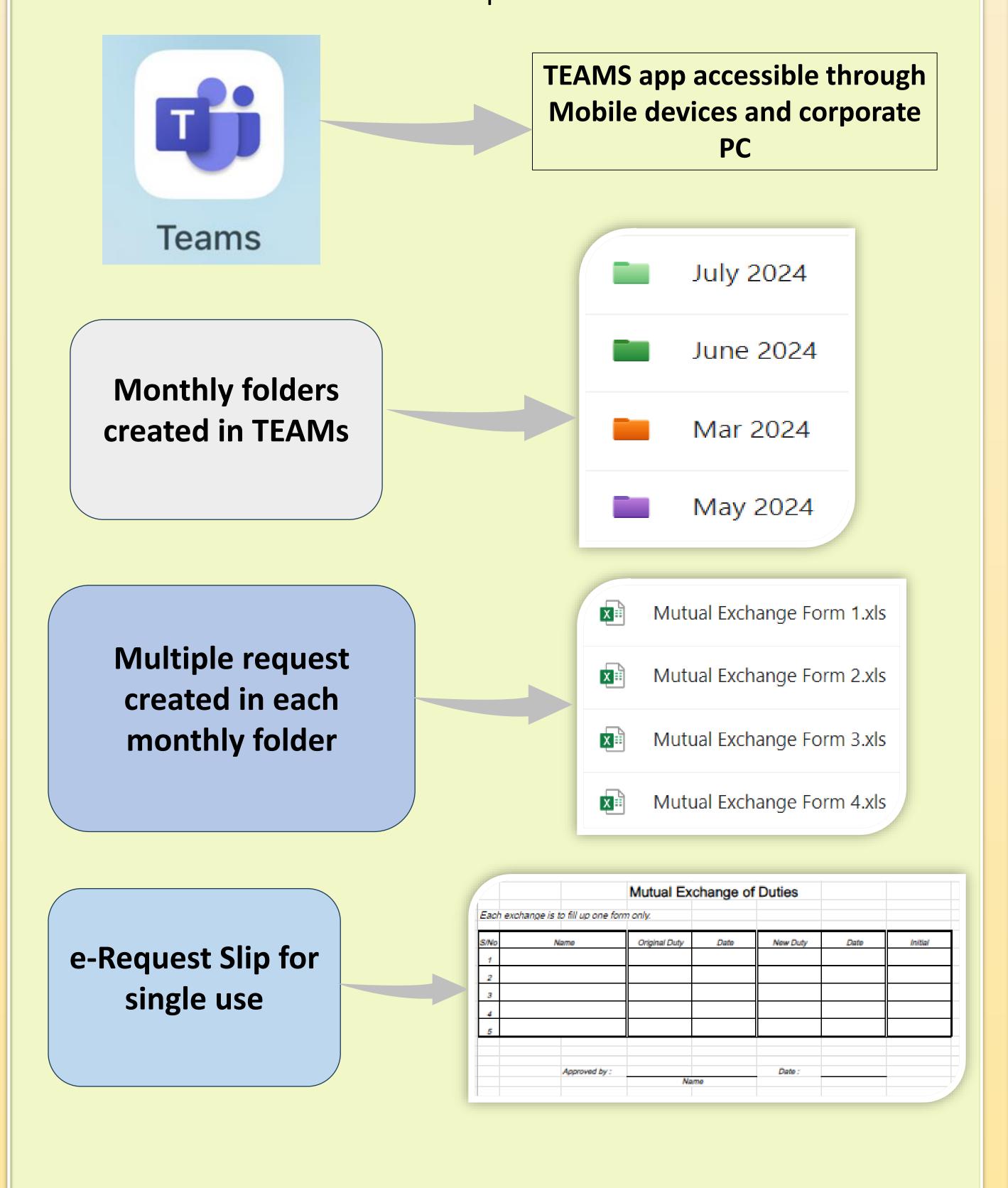
Objective

Digitalization of mutual exchange of duties and leave request using electronic request (e-request) for staff and manpower deployment incharge (MDI).

Method

TEAMs were tapped on to embark on this ideation of digitalization and paperless system since January 2024. A channel was created within TEAMs for staff to submit their e-request.

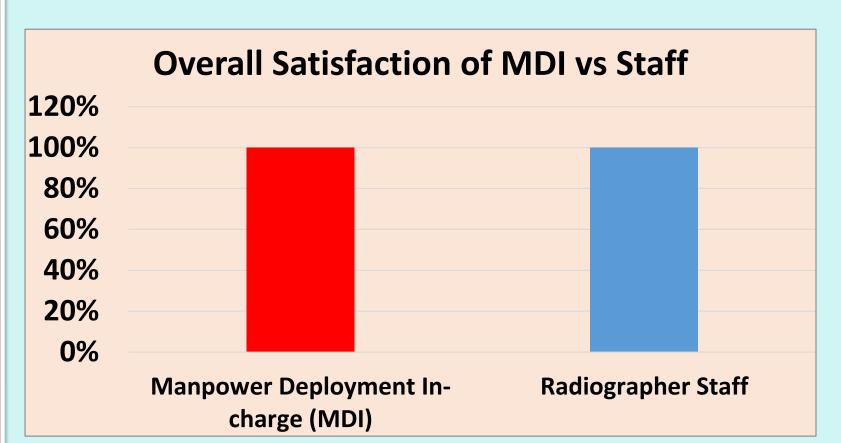


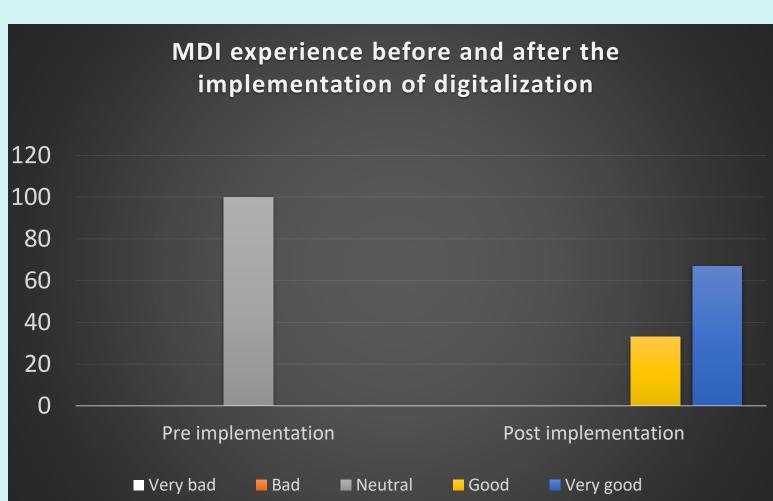
Workflow for e-request mutual exchange of duties and approval



Results

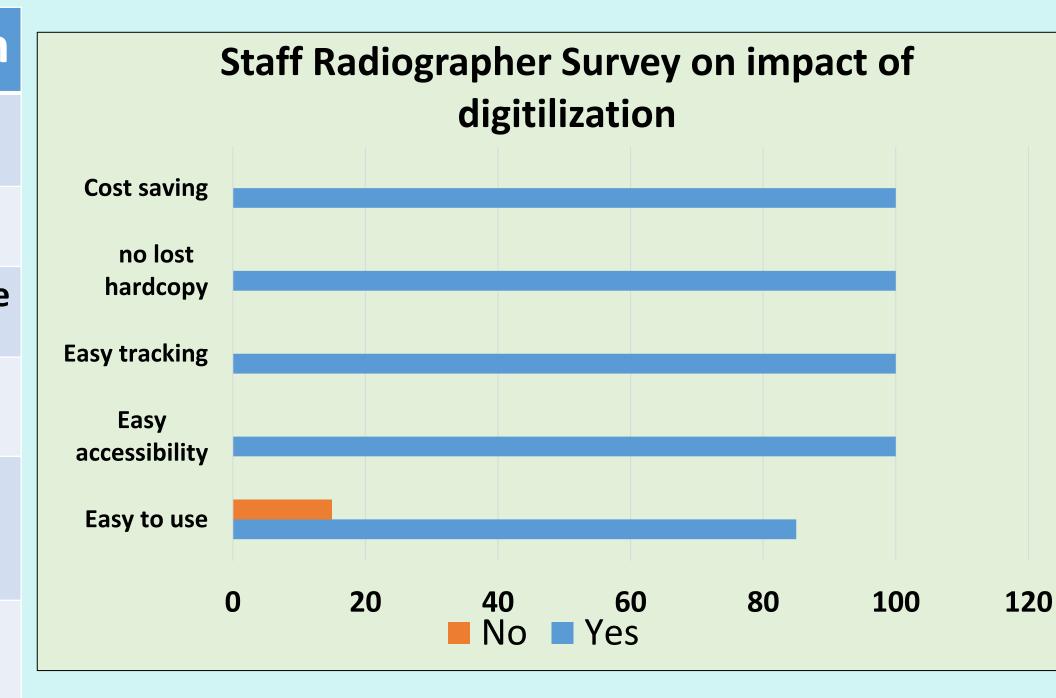
These new work around affects 2 group of Radiographers: Manpower Deployment Incharge (MDI) and staff. A poll conducted to assess the overall satisfaction in these 2 groups, on the transition towards digitalization. Poll gathered from staff radiographers, all in favour of digitalization transition (100%). The MDI also echoed the same positive feedback with 100% overall satisfaction.





A survey was also collected to gather the feedback on the experience that the MDI had in doing deployment before and after the implementation of the digitalization. The positive result is as shown in the graph above, MDI reported as Good (33%) and Very good (67%) experience as compared to pre implementation (100% says neutral).





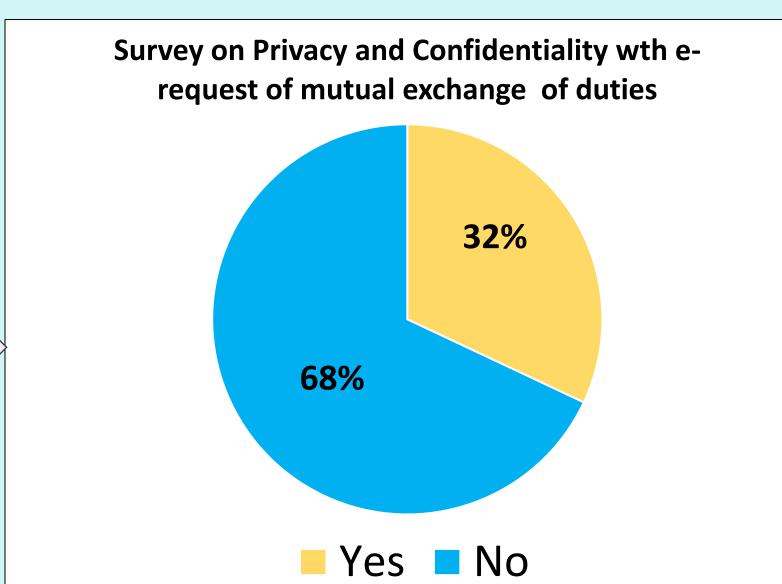
20 staff radiographers took part in a survey on the impacts of digitalization (listed in the table above). The survey yielded 100% of staff in agreement of all the positive impacts, as shown in the graph above except for the impact on 'easy to use, fast and hassle free'. 85% of staff finds it easy to use as opposed to 15% who thinks otherwise. The 15% of staff who do not find it easy to use can be explained mainly due to their first time use,

Staff were also surveyed on issues of privacy and confidentiality, 32% staff expressed that they are not comfortable with the open system.

However, 68% of staff has no issues regarding privacy

and confidentiality.

Conclusion

Staff feels more empowered as they are able to take charge of their own well-being in the ease and flexibility of changing their shift duties to fit in with their personal and family commitment.

Transition towards digitalization of the e-request mutual change of duties resulted in positive impacts to both staff and MDI. Up to date there is no major setbacks or issues arises brought about by these transition using TEAMs.
