SCAN IT, FIND IT







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BACKGROUND

At the Singapore National Eye Centre (SNEC), where approximately 27,000 ophthalmic surgeries are conducted annually, the challenge of catering to the diverse preferences of approximate 80 surgeons is evident. Operating Theatre (OT) nurses, tasked with the daily surgical preparation for these surgeons, encounter difficulties due to the range of preferences. Accessing hardcopy preference cardex from a centralized location is essential for compiling the daily surgical lists. This process involves ordering necessary instruments for surgery and verifying the surgeons' procedural steps, highlighting the crucial role of meticulous preparation in ensuring smooth surgical operations.

AIM

The team aim to improve efficiency of OT preparation and streamline daily preparation process by utilizing technology in the fast-paced ophthalmic OT environment.

METHODOLOGY

Inefficient Surgery List Preparation

Root Cause

Only 1 file to be shared by 60 nurses. Staff unable to locate file /surgeon's preferences not updated/ missing pages.

Does the QR code bring convenience & easy access in daily preparation?



CONCLUSION

The implementation of QR code has heightened the efficiency and productivity of scrub nurses in preparing surgical instruments for the following day. This has significantly reduced in preparation time, affording convenient access to preferences whenever needed, while also championing environmental sustainability by curbing paper usage to fosters a greener harmonious work environment.

Future Work

This project can possibly be translated to other settings with similar complexities of surgical cases and catering to different surgeons. It also helps to better equip the nurses which reduces the tension and stress level in the surgical team and enhance overall productivity.
