- Sourcing Events have access to ~4,000,000 suppliers via Ariba Network
- Automatic matching of qualifying suppliers to products and services
- Centralised platform for Suppliers to respond to ALPS' Sourcing events
- Centralised storage for all supporting documents throughout the Sourcing lifecycle
- Replicate Purchase Requisition (PR) details to Sourcing Events
- Allows online Declaration of Conflict of Interest (DCOI), Evaluation Criteria and scoring / evaluation
- Approvals can be done via Ariba web, email hyperlink or Ariba Mobile App

Requisition to Order enables end-users to create purchase requisitions while conducting real-time budget checks for selected PHIs.



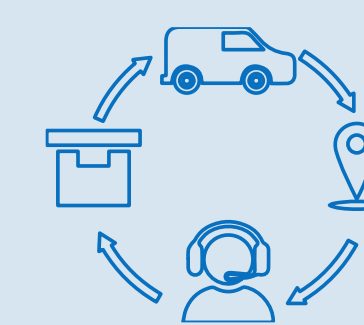
E-Catalogue is designed with the end-user in mind, offering a user-friendly experience for browsing and finding items for purchase requisitions online, making the process comfortable and easy.



Contract Management provides contract management and tracking, including an online signing feature using DocuSign.

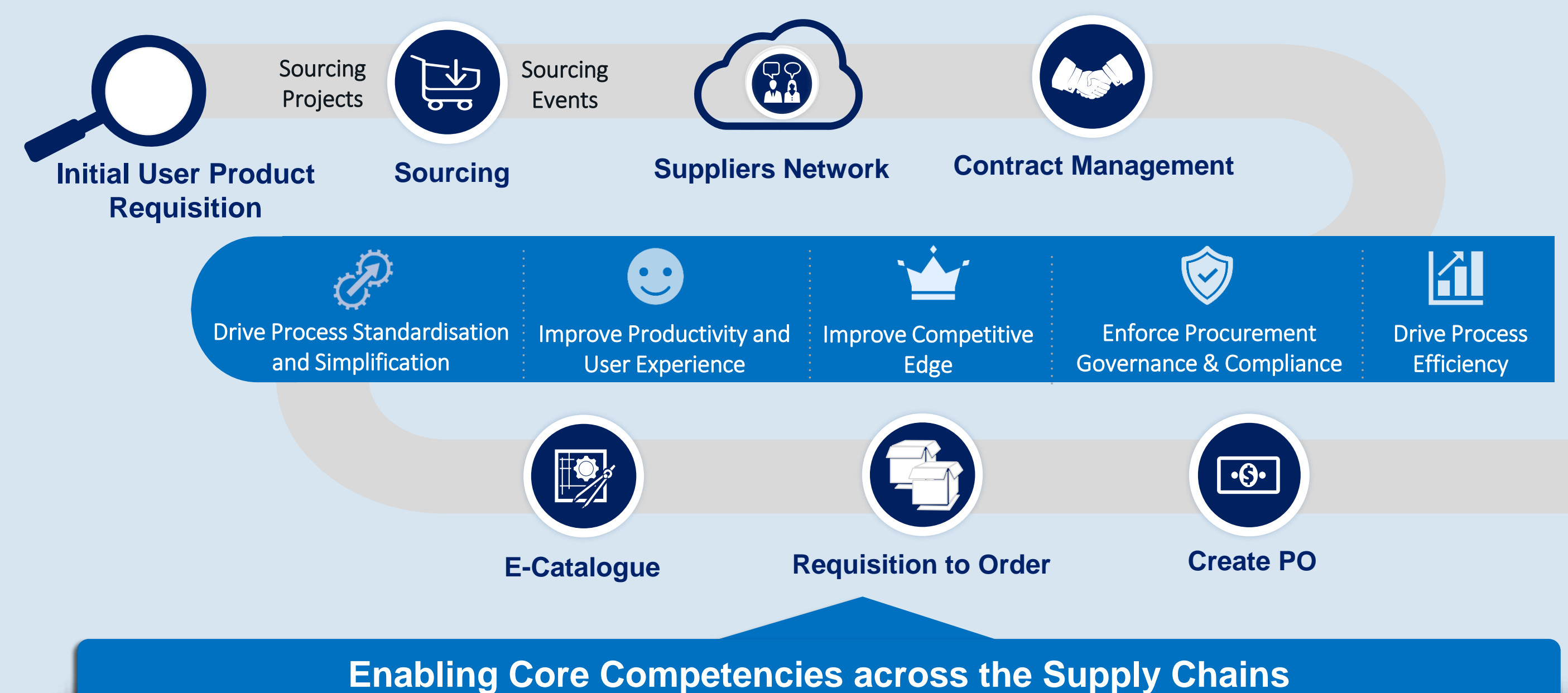


Purchase Order can be generated using SAP ECC6 systems with smooth system interfaces.
