Background


Mr Ong (ESTHER) 73 years old Chinese male have history of multiple hospital admission due to elevated HbA1c of more than 14% and multiple falls. He is due for his cataract operation. However, due to his high HbA1c level, his operation is postponed. He expressed that he has issues administering his insulin due to poor eyesight and he stopped taking all his medications as they confuses him.

His frequent admissions to the hospital has affected him financially. As a result, he is unable to socialize with his friends as regularly. This project aims to reduce ESTHER's hospital admissions, improve his HbA1c control and empower ESTHER in managing his diet so as to optimise his HbA1c level. ESTHER will also be resourceful in engaging community services to aid with his medications. **During Esther Café interview:**

Issues that ESTHER is facing:

- Unable to see the numbers on the insulin syringe
- Patient is referred to the community nurse to assist with the insulin injection and medication packing
- Do not own a fridge
- Refer MSW to aid with ESTHER's financial needs
- Fei Yue senior center will assist to provide the fridge
- Unsure of the medication that he is taking
- Esther sent for medication reconcile
- Pharmacist will go through the medication with ESTHER again.

Solutions and Implementation

Second session of Esther Café on 22 Mar 2023:

- Visited ESTHER's house in Chua Chu kang he stays in a rented house shared with his room mate
- Noticed a wall partition made from card boards by the room mate for privacy
- Bukit Merah Polyclinic collaborated with Care Manager Megawati from NUH for ESTHER's care
- Planned a visit to ESTHER's house on the day of the Nurse visit
- Met with Staff Nurse Jaden from Global Alliance
- ESTHER was referred to the Global alliance by NUH during his last admission
- ESTHER receive a small fridge from Fei Yue senior center to keep his insulin
- Nurse Jaden assisted to withdraw the insulin doses for Esther weekly
- Nurse Jaden assisted ESTHER with medication packing, withdrawing of insulin and hypocount checking
- Noticed grab bars have been fixed inside toilet and its entrance (these were fixed prior to last hospital admission)
- Toilet floor was seen slippery, reinforced to ESTHER on the use of non-slip mat

Volunteers from Fei Yue senior center donated a small fridge to ESTHER _


ESTHER's Admission to Hospital reduced and his HbA1c is down trending



Nurse organized ESTHER's medications.




ESTHER brought project team to Fei Yue Senior Centre to meet the center's in-charge Ms Nicole

Outcomes

ESTHER's HbA1c trend from Jan to Nov 2023:



ESTHER's HbA1c is checked every 3 monthly during clinic visit and it shows down trending latest HbA1c is 6.4% (27 Oct 2023).

Learning Points

- When patients are involved during the care discussion, we can focus on what really matters to patient
- What matters to Nurses and Doctors may not matter to patients
- Designing a person-centered care for ESTHERS is beneficial to them

Future Plans

To customize person-centered care for ESTHERS so as to promote holistic care through concerted efforts from all polyclinic ESTHERS.
